Annex 2: Remuneration of the Central Bank

- The remuneration of the Central Bank shall be calculated on the basis of the costs incurred with the management of the Fund.
- 2. The upper limit for the remuneration calculated for the period 1 January-31 December 2010 shall be five million five hundred and fifty six thousand US dollars (US\$ 5,556,000), including internal management costs of one million six hundred and sixty three US dollar (US\$1,663,000), Investment Advisory Board's costs of one hundred and forty five thousand US dollar (US\$145,000), and direct external management costs and custodian fee of three million seven hundred and forty eight thousand US dollars (US\$3,748,000).
- 3. The remuneration may be drawn in monthly installments from the assets of the Fund.
- In addition to recovering the costs limited to the value of remuneration set forth in paragraph 2 of this Annex, the Central Bank shall receive remuneration for fee associated with future commercial external managers' arrangements.
