## LICENSE APPLICATION FOR CURRENCY EXCHANGE BUREAU

## A. General Information Required:

- 1. Application in writing and in official language of Timor-Leste or in English language.
- 2. Original application and two copies together with a non-refundable application processing fee. (Download on Notification on fees)
- 3. If the applicant is an individual person, application must be signed by the person. If the applicant is a business entity, the application must be signed by an authorized officer of the business entity.
- 4. Applicant should authorize in writing a spokesperson to act on behalf of applicant Currency Exchanges Bureau (CEB), provide the name, address and telephone number.
- 5. Any changes in information on item 4, BPA should be notified in writing.

## **B.** Content of Application:

- 1. Detailed background information/CV, name, residential address, nationalities and specimen signature of the owners, principal officers and directors.
- 2. Name of the proposed CEB, clear identification of the physical location, together with the postal address.
- 3. A declaration that the applicant has never been declared bankrupt, free from any criminal proceeding, money laundering, tax evasion or any other act of dishonesty.
- 4. Copy of registration as a business.

Note: - Legal time frame for processing an application and for BPA's decision is within 6 (six) weeks.
